SUBJECT: **2021-22 Cal Grant C Awards**

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the 2021-22 Cal Grant C awards.

The Commission processed the Cal Grant C applicants and offered awards to students who indicated they will be pursuing a technical/occupational degree or vocational certificate, on their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) /California Dream Act Application (CADAA).

Based on the initial Cal Grant C award cycle:

- Cal Grant C award offers were processed on June 18, 2021.
- Currently, 4,845 Cal Grant C Supplement Forms have been returned for the 2021-22 Cal Grant C with over 4,608 awards offered.
- Institutions may now view new Cal Grant C recipients on their rosters.
- Students must complete the Cal Grant C Supplement via [WebGrants 4 Students](#) to confirm program eligibility.
- Schools can download the *Cal C Supplement Recipient Report* to confirm submission of students' Cal Grant C Supplement forms.
- California Community Colleges maximum award is \$1,094 for books and supplies.* Students who have dependent children may be eligible for an access award up to \$4,000.**
- Maximum award amount for other qualifying colleges and universities is \$2,462 for tuition and fees, plus an additional \$547 for books and supplies.*
- The Commission will continue to process Cal Grant C award offers until all 7,761 awards are utilized.
