Draft Institutional Participation Agreement

March Public Meeting Information

As outlined in a California Student Aid Commission *Special Alert*, the Commission has created a public comment period to allow stakeholders to provide input on the draft Institutional Participation Agreement (IPA). This document is a legal agreement between institutions and the Commission regarding participation in the Cal Grant Program. As part of this comment period, the Commission has established two public meetings and one Web conference. You can choose from three meetings to be held in March: one in northern California, one in southern California and a Web conference. *See next page for Web conference details.*

1) Northern California Workshop-

The Northern California Institutional Participation Agreement (IPA) workshop will take place on Friday, March 9, 2007, at California State University-Sacramento (CSUS) in the Redwood Room of the University Union building. CSUS is located at 6000 J Street, Sacramento.

The workshop will be from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Attendees may park in the newly opened parking structure III (three) or in lots 7 or 8 behind the parking structure on the south side of the campus. You must obtain a daily parking permit, which costs \$5, from one of the machines located in the lots.
