

**FILLING OUT YOUR
ASSUMPTION PROGRAM OF
LOANS FOR EDUCATION (APLE)
FOR OUT-OF-STATE TEACHERS
APPLICATION FOR 2002-2003**



The APLE for Out-of-State Teachers is a competitive teacher incentive program designed to encourage out-of-state teachers to apply for and accept teaching positions in California K-12 public schools in 1) subject areas where a critical teacher shortage has been identified or 2) designated schools that meet criteria established by the Superintendent of Public Instruction. Designated schools include those that: serve a large population of students from low-income families, are located in rural areas, have a high percentage of teachers holding emergency permits and rank in the lowest 50 Percentile of the Academic Performance Index (API).

Applying for APLE Out-of-State is a two-step process. You must 1) complete the first page of the application (G-104), sign and date the back, *and* 2) submit the signed application to your Country Office of Education APLE Out-of-State Coordinator for submission to the California Student Aid Commission (Commission).

Tips for students

Applicants must:

-  Be nominated by the County Office of Education APLE Coordinator in order to participate in the Program.
-  Hold a teaching credential from your state of legal residence.
-  Have received one or more educational loans that still have an outstanding balance.
-  Not be in default or become delinquent in any state or federally insured educational loan;
-  Not currently live in California nor currently be employed as a teacher in California.



GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE 2002-2003 APLE APPLICATION

Instructions:

Question 10: Please enter the type of Out-of-State credential you currently hold including the date, and state you received it.

Question 11: Please enter the California Teaching Credentials that you intend to obtain.

Question 12: The areas listed have been designated as California shortage areas. You **must** check only **one** area in which you intend to teach. (**Note: The teaching area selected CANNOT be changed at a later date without the Commission's approval.**)

Question 13: Please enter the student loans that currently have outstanding balances. **If you do not have an outstanding loan, you are not eligible to apply for APLE.**

Question 14: Please enter the County, School District and School Name that you plan to teach at, as well as your start date.

Question 15: Please enter the date you plan to move to California.

****Remember to sign the back of your application and return to your APLE Out-of-State Coordinator****

Timeline of application

- **June** – Application materials go to participating County Office of Education.
- **June - September** – County Offices of Education submit nominations to the Commission.
- **October** – New participants are announced by the Commission
