Update on Institutional Participation Agreement (IPA)

Commission staff hosted an IPA workshop May 24 to discuss the following issues:

- high school graduation confirmation
- California residency
- separate or commingled accounts for Cal Grant funds.

Stakeholders from all postsecondary segments and K-12 schools attended and engaged in productive discussion, including three breakout sessions. The workshop was followed by a GAC meeting at which staff updated members concerning the discussions.

From the input received at the IPA workshop, staff will be drafting proposals to present to GAC for further review.

At this point, staff is nearing what it believes are proposed collaborative solutions on high school graduation confirmation and California residency. Staff members are continuing discussions on the separate or commingled account issue.

Another meeting with GAC is planned for July 2007.

Staff will keep the Commission posted on new developments.
