At the August 2<sup>nd</sup> CCCSFAAA Board meeting, I gave a Cal Grant Update that included the re-evaluation Cal Grant records to reflect the final state budget. One possible outcome of the re-evaluation was a change in award type from a Cal Grant A or C to a Cal Grant B. At that time, some of the CCCSFAAA representatives suggested that it would be very helpful if the Commission would provide information regarding any award changes to the schools directly.

We are happy to let you know that the Commission has prepared a special report called the "Award Type Change Summary" that will do what CCCSFAAA representatives have suggested. The reports are now available on the WebGrants Data Transfer Download screen for schools to access this information. Schools were notified of the availability of these reports in the Commission's Special Alert 2004-15.
