ASSUMPTION PROGRAM OF LOANS FOR EDUCATION (APLE) FOR CREDENTIALAED TEACHERS

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION

As an **APLE for Credentialed Teachers** participant you are responsible for the following:

- Provide the Commission with current demographic contact information on a continual basis; and
- Continue to teach at an eligible California K-12 public school; and
- Continue to possess a clear single subject credential, clear multiple credential, or a level II education specialist credential
- Remain in good standing with your student loan lender(s)

REMINDER: The APLE for Credentialed Teachers loan assumption payment will not cancel or replace any scheduled payments. If your qualified educational loan(s) are in default no loan assumption payment will be made on your behalf and you will be withdrawn from the program.

As an APLE for Credentialed Teacher participant, your action will be required each academic year in order for the Commission to release a loan assumption payment to your lender. You will be required to verify your employment and student loan status. The employment and loan forms must be completed and returned to the Commission by the established deadlines.

You will be notified electronically at the end of each academic year (April / May) of how and where to download the following forms:

- Employment Compliance Verification Form; and
- Loan Balance Verification Form

The Commission will begin processing **APLE for Credentialed Teachers** loan assumption payments to lenders **after** the Governor signs the state budget act each year. You will be notified by the Commission electronically when your loan assumption payment is mailed to your lender. Any errors or blank areas on your forms may delay your loan assumption payment.
