SUBJECT: Assumption Program of Loans for Education (APLE) Update
and 2010-11 Academic Year Application Announcement

This Operations Memo provides an update on the status of the California Student Aid Commission's (Commission) Assumption Program of Loans for Education (APLE) for 2009-10 and 2010-11. APLE is a state-funded, competitive teacher incentive program designed to encourage outstanding students to become teachers and serve in areas within California where there is an identified critical teacher shortage.

2010-11 APLE Program

The priority deadline for 2010-11 APLE applications is **September 30, 2010**. If all allocations are not met by the priority deadline, the Commission will continue to accept eligible applications until the **June 30, 2011 deadline** or until the total allocations are disbursed, whichever occurs first.

A total of 7,100 applications were allocated to the 79 APLE participating institutions. Each institution receives a designated allocation based on the most current data available regarding the number of teaching credentials recommended by each institution. Please refer to the enclosed 2010-11 APLE Allocations listing to determine the number of allocations designated for your institution. However, the 2010-11 state budget may indicate a different number of authorized allocations. Commission staff will provide updates as information becomes available and will adjust the total allocations, if necessary.

2009-10 APLE Program

Currently the APLE allocations for 2009-10 have not been fully utilized. The Commission will continue to accept applications for the 2009-10 academic year until June 30, 2010. Applications received after June 30, 2010 will not be accepted. As a result, we encourage you to make every effort to publicize the availability of the program and disseminate information to potential applicants regarding the APLE program.

Pending the passage of the 2010-11 state budget, in August 2010, we anticipate beginning the processing of APLE payments for eligible teachers who have provided teaching service during the 2009-10 academic year.
