Dear Student:

The California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) had offered you financial aid in the form of a Cal Grant for the 2009-10 school year. At this time, no college has reported to us that you have been paid Cal Grant benefits for fall 2009 school term.

If you have been in attendance at a California college for this year, please contact your school financial aid office to see if they can pay you Cal Grant funds. The school determines if you can receive benefits in the Cal Grant program. Also, please log-in to WebGrants for Students as described below and report the name of that school to us.

If you are attending college outside of California, Cal Grant funds cannot be paid to you. Please let us know this so we can stop contacting you. Should you return to California, you can always apply again for Cal Grant assistance.

If you have not been enrolled in school, but intend to return in the future, you may take a leave of absence from the Cal Grant program and activate the award later. To report a leave of absence, log into WebGrants for Students at [www.webgrants4students.org](http://www.webgrants4students.org) and open an account. You can report the leave on-line.

If you or your school does not submit the information requested above by the end of the 2009-10 academic year, your Cal Grant award will be withdrawn.
