





**SUBJECT:** 2011-12 September 2 Competitive Awards

This Operations Memo informs institutions that the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) began processing the 2011-12 September 2 award cycle on October 7, 2011, and has now completed the selection process. Over 204,000 financially eligible applicants were considered for the available 11,250 September 2 Competitive awards for California Community College students, which are allocated by state law.

In addition to meeting the general Cal Grant A and B eligibility criteria, applicants were scored for Grade Point Average (GPA), household size and income, parents' educational level, household status and access equalizer using the Commission approved scoring criteria. Applicants with a score of 166 and above were offered an award. On October 10, 2011, e-mail notifications were sent to the selected students informing them to view their electronic California Aid Report (CAR) in WebGrants for Students (WGS). Students without an e-mail address will receive a paper CAR in the mail. All applicants can review their status online on WGS at [www.webgrants4students.org](http://www.webgrants4students.org).

WebGrants rosters now include the September 2 Competitive award recipients. A breakdown of the awards scoring for all Competitive Cal Grant students is available on the WebGrants Student Award Detail screen, including scoring information to help answer Cal Grant eligibility questions for this award.
