





SUBJECT: Transfer Entitlement Clarification

This Grant Operations Memo provides clarification for the 2013-14 [Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Certification Form \(G-6\)](#) and its impact on the students who were preliminarily selected in the California Community College Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Award (E2) program.

To qualify for an E2 award, students must meet the following requirements:

- Have graduated from a California high school or its equivalent after June 30, 2000;
- Be a California resident at the time of high school graduation;
- Be no more than 28 years of age by December 31 of the award year;
- Have attended at least one term at a California Community College (CCC) sometime during the 2012-13 academic year (AY); and
- Be transferring to a baccalaureate-degree-granting institution (BDGI) in 2013-14.

EXCEPTION: Students who attended a CCC in 2011-12 will be allowed to use a new 2013-14 Transfer Entitlement award starting in the 2013-14 academic year regardless of their 2012-13 enrollment status. (As allowed by the California Education Code Section 69436 (B))

Please note that in order to be eligible, students need only to have attended a CCC during any part of the 2011-12 academic year in the exception case as noted above. The exception also allows students who attended a CCC in 2011-12 to have enrollment at the BDGI in the 2012-13 year without impacting their 2013-14 E2 award status.

In addition, attendance at a BDGI is required for at least one term of the 2013-14 academic year, or the award offer is void.



The following table provides the most common scenarios of student enrollment and the corresponding E2 eligibility.

- *Any Student NOT attending a BDGI in the 2013-14 AY is ineligible for the 2013-14 Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Award (E2).*
- *Students who attended a CCC **and** a BDGI in the 2011-12 AY are ineligible for a 2013-14 E2 award.*
