

Message from the California Student Aid Commission regarding your Cal Grant Award



Dear \*|FNAME|\*:

This message is being sent to you from the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC), the state agency charged with administering the Cal Grant programs. Our records currently show you that you are attending a school that will not be eligible to participate in the Cal Grant Program for the 2013-14 academic year. Therefore, you will not be able to receive your Cal Grant award at this institution beginning with the 2013-14 Fall term. The school listed on your account is ineligible due to having either a high loan default rate or a low graduation rate or both.

You can either remain at your current campus, in which case your potential Cal Grant award will be withdrawn, or you can change your school of attendance to an eligible Cal Grant school. If you decide to transfer to an eligible campus, your new school of attendance is responsible for verifying that you still meet the Cal Grant eligibility requirements prior to disbursing Cal Grant. If the school determines that a student is not eligible, they have the authority to withdraw the award.

To continue receiving your Cal Grant you must report a School Change by logging-into WebGrants for Students (WGS) at [www.webgrants4students.org](http://www.webgrants4students.org). If this is your first time visiting WGS, you will need to create a WGS account by clicking the link that says, "Create an Account." Click the link that says, "Submit School Change." Select an eligible Cal Grant school from the drop down list under the, "School Change To" section, and select "Fall" from the "Term Change to Occur" drop down list. Then hit the "submit change" box to process the School Change.
