





SUBJECT: 2014-15 Child Development Grant Application Process

The California Student Aid Commission (Commission) is pleased to announce that the 2014-15 Child Development Grant Program new and renewal [applications](#) are now available for downloading from our website.

The Child Development Grant Program is a renewable, need-based grant of up to \$2,000 per year designed to encourage students to enter the field of child care and development in a licensed children's center. Students who plan to enroll at least half-time in coursework leading to a Child Development Permit are eligible to apply and be nominated by the postsecondary institution they plan to attend. Students must commit to one year of full-time service in a licensed children's center in California for each year they receive the grant.

Program awards will not automatically renew for the 2014-15 academic year, so participants who received an award for 2013-14 must complete a renewal application to be considered for 2014-15 funding. The postmark deadline to submit applications to the Commission is **May 16, 2014**.
