**SUBJECT: 2014-15 Cal Grant Community College Transfer Entitlement Awards**

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the processing of the 2014-15 Cal Grant California Community College Transfer Entitlement (E2) awards.

- The 2014-15 California Community College Transfer Entitlement award cycle identified 30,927 potentially eligible applicants.
- These offered awardees were notified to complete the online G-6 Transfer Entitlement self-certification form to be considered for the Cal Grant E2 award.

### **E2 offered awardees must:**

- Complete the G-6 form online in their WebGrants for Students (WGS) account at [www.webgrants4students.org](http://www.webgrants4students.org).
- Have graduated from a California high school or its equivalent after June 30, 2000;
- Be a California resident at the time of high school graduation;
- Be no more than 27 years of age;
- Have attended at least one term at a California Community College during the 2013-14 school year; and
- Be transferring to a baccalaureate degree-granting institution for 2014-15.

- ❖ No payment transactions allowed for the 2014-15 academic year until early August.
