Non-SSN GPA Matching Requirements and Resources

The Non-SSN GPAs must be matched to the students' application records in order for the students to be considered for a Cal Grant award offer (if they filed a FAFSA/Dream Application on time).

This process was detailed in [GOM 2014-10](#) released February 28, 2014.

To assist with this process, WebGrants contains a "Non-SSN GPA Matching Screen" and a *User Guide* (located within the Help Center tab). Also available are these reports:

Non-SSN GPA School Unmatched Report

Identifies which of your students remain unmatched.

Non-SSN GPA Status Report

Confirms that GPA records have been matched to FAFSA/Dream Applications.

Non-SSN GPA Roster Report

Confirms that all of your school's Non-SSN GPAs were successfully submitted for Cal Grant consideration.
