SUBJECT: **2014-15 Transfer Entitlement Processing Corrections**

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) reports a system processing issue related to Transfer Entitlement students for the 2014-15 award process. Below is a description of the issue and students who are affected.

System Processing Issue

- When the Commission ran the September 2nd Competitive Award Cycle, students who had previously been withdrawn were reconsidered for a Transfer Entitlement award.
- These ineligible students re-appeared on campus rosters with a pending G-6 flag.

Who Is Affected

- Students who were notified of a preliminary Transfer Entitlement offer for the 2014-15 academic year, but were withdrawn due to their G-6 responses (typically the students were not eligible for the Transfer Entitlement award).
- Approximately 1,300 students were affected by this processing error.

The Commission will withdraw these students on Wednesday, December 3, 2014.
