This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) is pleased to announce that the 2015-16 online California Dream Act Application (CA Dream Application) was successfully released on January 1, 2015 and can be accessed at www.caldreamact.org.

- Students eligible under Assembly Bill (AB) 540 and AB 2000 can apply for Cal Grants and other state financial aid benefits using this application.
- Students requiring a paper application can download the paper CA Dream Application by accessing the same Web page. Online application is strongly encouraged since it is faster, easier and provides the applicant with immediate feedback.

- 2015-16 Cal ISIRs will be available for download starting on January 19, 2015.
