





**SUBJECT:** Webinars on Senate Bill 451 and the Cal Grant C Program

Senate Bill (SB) 451 requires the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) to give priority in granting Cal Grant C awards to students pursuing occupational or technical training in areas that meet specified criteria starting with the 2012-13 academic year. Commission staff held two Cal Grant Update webinars on May 8 and May 16, which included information on the changes to the Cal Grant C program.

Commission staff will host two webinar sessions to provide an overview of the Cal Grant C program selection criteria, implementation process, and more details regarding SB 451.
