SUBJECT: Lists of Eligible and Ineligible Cal Grant Schools for 2013-14

The purpose of this Special Alert is to provide the lists of Eligible and Ineligible Cal Grant Schools for the 2013-14 academic year. These lists are located on the California Student Aid Commission's (Commission) website at www.csac.ca.gov (click on "Cal Grant Eligible Schools" from the homepage). Ineligible Cal Grant schools were sent communications informing them of their status.

As you know, the Commission is required to certify by October 1 of each year a student loan cohort default rate (CDR) and graduation rate for an otherwise qualifying institution of higher education that seeks to participate in the Cal Grant Program. The CDR and graduation rate information are taken directly from federal data published by the U.S. Department of Education. These two requirements are used to determine if an interested institution of higher education is eligible to participate in the Cal Grant Program.
