





SUBJECT: California Dream Act Cal ISIR Correction Screen Training

This Special Alert notifies financial aid administrators that the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) will be hosting online webinars to present the new WebGrants California Dream Act Cal ISIR Correction Screen.

Commission staff will provide a presentation on using the Cal ISIR Correction Screen to make Cal ISIR corrections, confirm Verification, and perform Dependency Overrides. The Correction Screen also features a built in EFC simulator so users can preview EFC changes prior to submitting a correction.

Webinar participants can log on from their own office or home computer and follow along screen-by-screen while listening to the live audio feed over the phone. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and receive immediate answers.

The Commission will hold webinars on **Thursday, March 21** at 10:00 a.m. and **Tuesday, March 26** at 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Each online training session will be approximately one hour.
