





Update of the California Student Aid Commission

**TO:** Financial Aid Administrators

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**SUBJECT:** Senate Bill 70 Data Reporting Requirements

As noted in the California Student Aid Commission's (Commission) Grant Special Alert [\(GSA\) 2013-31](#), the deadline for reporting the data required by California Education Code (CEC) section 69433.2 has been extended to **March 31, 2014** for all institutions. Cal Grant participating institutions will have access to submit these data on WebGrants beginning **March 1, 2014**. The reporting process will close for submissions on March 31, 2014.

The Commission is pleased to announce the launch of a new [SB 70 Institution Search](#) Web page that allows you to search and view enrollment data submitted by institutions for the 2011-12 academic year. A link to this search feature is also available at the bottom of the [main SB 70 Web page](#).

## Enrollment, Persistence and Graduation Data

The file import specifications for enrollment, persistence, and graduation have not changed from last year and can be accessed on the Commission's website at <http://www.csac.ca.gov/doc.asp?id=1427>. A revised *SB 70 Institutional Data Reporting User Guide* will be released to assist with the submission of required data.

Also, the Commission will host a series of webinars to discuss the data collection requirements and the submission process. The first of these webinars is scheduled for February 10, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. To register for this training, visit the Commission's website at [www.csac.ca.gov/doc.asp?id=1445](http://www.csac.ca.gov/doc.asp?id=1445). Once you have registered, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to you with the website login instructions and teleconference phone line information. Retain this confirmation e-mail, as you will need it to join the webinar.

Each online training session will be approximately one hour. Participants can log on from their office or home computer and follow along screen-by-screen while listening to the live audio feed over the phone. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and receive immediate answers.



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**Job Placement and Salary and Wage Reporting**

The Commission also will hold on-going workgroup meetings to discuss the development of the methodology for reporting the job placement and salary/wage data required by CEC section 69433.2(a)(2). The Commission is currently scheduling meetings with representatives from the impacted segments.

**Unitary Data Reporting**

The Commission will be accepting unitary data submissions for any institution that would prefer to have the Commission aggregate their data. Once Commission staff aggregates the unitary data, the aggregate reports will be sent back to the institution for verification and approval. Institutions will have the opportunity to make corrections if the data appear to be flawed. Unitary data must still be submitted by the March 31, 2014 reporting deadline. Commission staff will aggregate the data following the close of the reporting period.
