SUBJECT: 2017-18 Cal Grant High School Entitlement Award Claiming Process

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces the capability for students to claim and activate their 2017-18 Cal Grant award.

- As referenced in <u>GOM 2016-33</u>, Cal Grant eligible students should create a WebGrants for Students (WGS) account at <u>www.webgrants4students.org</u> for additional information regarding their Cal Grant award offer.
- Cal Grant eligible students receive a paper <u>Cal Grant Eligibility Notification</u>, informing them of the steps to take to confirm their award.

Beginning with the 2017-18 academic year, Cal Grant eligible students are advised to satisfy specific requirements on their WGS account to claim their award.

- Confirmation of School of Attendance: Students have the capability to select the "Confirmation of School of Attendance" link in WGS to confirm the school they will attend during the 2017-18 academic year.
- High School Graduation Confirmation: Beginning the first day of the month of the student's graduation, students will have the capability to select the "Submit High School Graduation Confirmation" link in WGS to confirm they have graduated from high school.

Students who are required to fulfill these requirements will see a red stop sign. Once satisfied, the red stop sign and links will disappear.
