## **Update from the California Student Aid Commission**

SUBJECT: California Chafee Grant Program Year End Reconciliation Deadline

This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) reminds schools of the reconciliation deadline for the California Chafee Grant Program (Chafee Program).

### 2020-21 Remaining Funds

- As of August 24, 2021, CSAC has awarded \$18,843,214 for 2020-21 which includes funding from the federal COVID relief package, HR 133, P.L. 116-260 (as mentioned in <u>GSA-2021-15</u>). Please continue to work your rosters to provide as much of these funds as possible to Chafee eligible students. Any funds remaining after September will be added to the 2021-22 award funds. Let's work together to maximize the utilization of available funds to assist eligible foster youth.
- Institutions are required to review their Payment Roster on <u>WebGrants</u> weekly to certify and request payments for all eligible Chafee students. The Chafee payment cycle is run on Monday nights. Institutions should review their rosters on Tuesdays.

#### **Non-Disbursed Chafee Checks**

- All non-disbursed checks must be returned to the Commission within 30 business days of receipt. This will allow the Commission to maximize the utilization of available Chafee funds.
- Complete the form attached to the check and do not void the check. Return both to:

#### 2020-21 Institutional Reconciliation

- The last 2020-21 Chafee payment cycle will be processed on September 20, 2021.
  \*The last time our system will award students based on the priority selection criteria.
- Institutions are required to update their *Institution Reconciliation* screen to report all disbursed and returned checks by **September 30, 2021**.
