SUBJECT: September 2 Competitive Cal Grant Community College Enrollment

and GPA Submission Information

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides guidance to California Community Colleges (CCC) regarding the 2016-17 September 2 Grade Point Average (GPA) and enrollment submission processes for the Competitive Cal Grant A and B programs. These awards are for students attending an eligible CCC this 2016-17 Fall term.

Students eligible to participate in the September 2, 2016 Cal Grant CCC Competition are those who:

- Did not receive a March 2, 2016 Cal Grant award.
- Applied after the March 2, 2016 deadline.
- Have completed a 2016-17 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) postmarked or posted online by September 2, 2016.
- Have submitted a verified GPA to the Commission for the 2016-17 award year by September 2, 2016.
- Have their Social Security number included on a CCC enrollment upload file.

Students offered an award must enroll in and attend a California Community College for the 2016-17 fall term to receive payment.

#### **Cal Grant GPA Verification and Submission**

- The deadline for GPA submission is September 2, 2016.
- Refer to the <u>Cal Grant GPA Calculation Instructions</u> for complete details on how to calculate a high school, college, community college or reestablished GPA.
- Authorized school officials are encouraged to submit verified GPAs by uploading data files through WebGrants using the regular GPA upload option. Refer to the WebGrants GPA Upload Record Layout for the file specifications.

- When uploading both regular and reestablished GPAs, each requires a separate data file upload.
- Identify Community College Reestablished GPAs by clicking in the *Re-established* check box before uploading.
- If a student chooses to submit the paper <u>Cal Grant GPA Verification form</u>, advise the student to keep a copy for their records and obtain a \$1.35 U.S. Postal Certificate of Mailing, which must be postmarked no later than September 2, 2016.
- If completing a paper GPA Verification Form, fill in the oval that identifies the verified GPA as a reestablished GPA, if applicable.

### California Community College Enrollment Verification and Submission

- Upload enrollment data files directly to the Commission through WebGrants. Users have the option to upload a complete data file or to enter individual records. The Enrollment Record Layout Specifications are the same as last year.
- California Community Colleges should report the Social Security numbers of all students enrolled for Fall 2016, regardless of the number of units in which the student is enrolled.
- Both semester and quarter Community College campuses submit enrollment data no later than September 16, 2016.
- The Commission anticipates processing the September 2 competitive award cycle in late September.
