SUBJECT: 2016-17 Transfer Entitlement Awards

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the 2016-17 California Community College (CCC) Transfer Entitlement Awards. The Commission successfully processed the 2016-17 preliminary CCC Transfer Entitlement Awards.

- The Commission identified approximately 31,459 applicants with potential eligibility for the Transfer Entitlement Award and notified them to complete the G-6 self-certification form.
- Please encourage students to complete the G-6 self-certification form by logging into their WebGrants for Student account at: www.webgrants4students.org.
- The Commission will continue to process the G-6 self-certification form on a weekly basis.
- Cal Grant Rosters are now available in WebGrants to process school change transactions.

Students must meet the following criteria to be eligible for a 2016-17 CCC Transfer Entitlement Award:

- ➤ Completed a 2016-17 FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application by March 2, 2016.
- Attended a CCC during the 2015-16 academic year.
- Plan to transfer from a CCC to a bachelor degree granting institution (BDGI) during the 2016-17 academic year.
- Graduated from a California high school or its equivalent after June 30, 2000.
- > Were California residents at the time of high school graduation.
- > Are no more than 27 years of age.
- > Submitted a CCC GPA of at least 2.4.
