SUBJECT: 2016-17 September 2 Competitive Cal Grant Reminder

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides guidance to California Community Colleges (CCC) regarding the 2016-17 September 2 enrollment submission and Grade Point Average (GPA) processes for the Competitive Cal Grant A and B programs. These awards are for students attending an eligible CCC this 2016-17 fall term.

Students eligible to participate in the 2016-17 Cal Grant CCC Competition are those who:

- Did not receive a March 2 Cal Grant award.
- Applied after the March 2 deadline.
- Have completed a 2016-17 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) postmarked or posted online by September 2, 2016.
- Have submitted a verified GPA to the Commission for the 2016-17 award year by September 2, 2016.
- Are listed on a 2016-17 CCC enrollment file.

CCC Enrollment Verification and Submission

- Upload enrollment data files directly to the Commission through WebGrants. Users have the option to upload a complete data file or to enter individual records. The <u>Enrollment Record Layout Specifications</u> are the same as last year.
- CCCs should report all students enrolled for fall 2016, regardless of the number of units in which the student is enrolled.
- Both semester and quarter community college campuses must submit enrollment data no later than September 12, 2016.
- The Commission anticipates processing the September 2 competitive award cycle after all enrollment files are submitted.

Cal Grant GPA Verification and Submission

- Refer to the <u>Cal Grant GPA Calculation Instructions</u> for complete details on how to calculate a high school, college, community college or re-established GPA.
- Authorized school officials are encouraged to submit verified GPAs by uploading data files through WebGrants using the regular GPA upload option. Refer to the WebGrants GPA Upload Record Layout for the file specifications. The deadline for GPA submission is September 2, 2016.
- If a student chooses to submit the paper <u>Cal Grant GPA Verification form</u>, advise the student to keep a copy for their records and obtain a \$1.30 U.S. Postal Certificate of Mailing, which must be postmarked no later than September 2, 2016.
- Identify CCC re-established GPAs by choosing the re-established check box before uploading. When uploading both regular and re-established GPAs, each requires a separate data file upload.
- If completing a paper GPA Verification Form, fill in the oval that identifies the verified GPA as a re-established GPA, if applicable.

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
