SUBJECT: 2019-20 Student Expense Budget / Income and Asset Ceilings

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces the release of the 2019-20 <u>Student Expense Budgets</u> and <u>Income and Asset</u> <u>Ceilings</u>.

- The statewide Student Expense Budgets are adjusted annually using the California Consumer Price Indices. The 2019-20 budgets include standardized allowances for food, housing, books/supplies, transportation, and personal/miscellaneous expenses based on a nine-month academic year.
- The 2019-20 Cal Grant Income and Asset Ceilings were calculated using the prescribed methodology from the 2006-07 Student Expenses and Resources Survey (SEARS), adjusted for 13 years of inflation or deflation, and further adjusted based on data from the 2018 SEARS pilot.
- Actual campus budget information provided by the institutions on WebGrants, or on a College Cost Estimate form, will be used for Cal Grant awarding.
- California Education Code section 69432.7(k) states that the maximum household Income and Asset Ceilings applicable for a renewing recipient be the higher of:
 - 1. The adjusted ceilings for the year; or
 - 2. The ceilings at the time of the renewing recipient's initial Cal Grant award.
- The 2019-20 Income and Asset Ceilings will be the same for new and renewal Cal Grant students.
