Good news!

You have been preliminarily selected to receive an increased Cal Grant Supplemental Access award. On your 2019-20 FAFSA/CADAA application you indicated having dependent children that you support, as such you may be eligible to receive additional funding to help pay your college expenses.

California Governor Gavin Newsom and the State Legislature approved new funding to increase your Cal Grant award in 2019-20. Students attending a UC, CSU, or California Community College who have dependent children, receiving more than half of their support from you and who are under the age of 18, might now be eligible to receive an access award of up to \$6,000.

The California Student Aid Commission is currently updating its Cal Grant processing system to implement this new program and will provide the additional funding through your campus before the end of the 2019-20 fall term. Please note that your school of attendance will make the final determination of your Cal Grant eligibility and the supplemental access award.

So, what's next?

- Log on to <u>www.webgrants4students.org</u> and create your online WebGrants for Students (WG4S) account if you have not created one previously.
- Routinely check the status of your Cal Grant and maintain your demographic information current and updated.

- Your college will notify you once they have added the additional amount to your Cal Grant, if
 you are determined eligible. Make sure to check your campus student account or contact
 your financial aid office for Cal Grant disbursement dates.
- Check for other outstanding requirements at your college. For example, your application may
 be selected for verification. That means your campus may want you to submit extra
 documents to confirm your eligibility before they pay out your funds.
