The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) & CA Dream Act Application (CADAA) for 2024-25 is now open! Meet the state priority deadline of May 2, 2024\*. Some colleges have earlier deadlines for institutional aid, so check with your colleges to ensure you are meeting all important deadlines.
