The GDS Modernization supports current and future growth of the Grant Program making grants more accessible to students with improved transparency, agility, maintainability, security, delivery, and adaptability to changes.

Project Management

The Q4 of 2020 release of CADAA and WebGrants for Institutions will complete the transition to the new GDS modernized unified platform. While GDSM made many improvements to underlying infrastructure as well as making the GDSM system accessible across popular browsers and devices, much of the interaction remains the same. This includes menus, forms, and screens that remain consistent with the legacy system. Some automation of some previously manual processes has been included to improve access.

Once a user has logged into their account, they will be presented with the WebGrants “Home Page.” The Home Page features central navigation to all CSAC programs, reducing the number of clicks needed to access any function within the application. WebGrants is accessible through most devices, browsers, and operating systems, and is Americans with Disabilities Act compliant. Users can access the application from many common hardware and software applications as well as accommodate ability limitations. The WebGrants display is also dynamic in two ways. First, the WebGrants display will reorient itself depending on the device being used. A user’s screen will only display the level of access in which they are granted.

The GDSM development continues once programs are moved to the new unified platform. Below are some of the enhancements added to WebGrants for Students released in the 4th quarter of 2019.

September 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Award Status Card now displays the link to Cal Grant Appeals G-18 Form that shows how to submit an appeal. Many of the students need a little additional information about submitting an appeal. This link navigates students to the G-18 form page on the CSAC website.
July August 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School of Attendance Card now displays the amounts for students who are in a pending status based on the school • A Link was added to the Cal Grant Award Amount FAQs Sheet for students to get more information about the award amounts at specific campuses.
