

California Golden State Teacher Grant Program

The Golden State Teacher Grant program (GSTG) is for students who are currently enrolled in a teacher preparation program based in California, to earn a credential in a high-need field and commit to teach at a priority school in California. The California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) will provide grant funds of up to twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to teaching candidates.

Who is eligible?

- Students enrolled on or after January 1, 2020 in a teacher preparation program based in California, approved by the Commission on Teaching Credentialing (CTC)
- Students working toward a preliminary teaching credential
- Students enrolled in teacher resident and intern programs

What is a 'high-need' field?

- Bilingual education
- Science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM), including computer science and career technical education in STEM subjects
- Multiple subject instruction
- Special education
- Transitional kindergarten
- Other subjects as designated annually by the CTC
