This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the award amount changes as prescribed in the 2015-16 Budget Act and provides guidance regarding the 2015-16 renewal of Cal Grant Dreamers eligible to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

#### 2015-16 Cal Grant Award Amounts

Rosters displaying the updated award amounts are now available on WebGrants.

- \$1,656 Cal Grant B Access Award
- **\$9,084** Maximum Cal Grant A and B Tuition award for new recipients attending private, non-profit institutions, and WASC accredited for-profit institutions.

The tables below display award amounts for the two changes listed above by both semester and quarter disbursements, in addition to full-time (FT), three quarter-time (TT), and half-time (HT) status award amounts:

### 2015-16 Dream Act Renewals Eligible to File a FAFSA

Cal Grant students awarded in 2014-15 under the CA Dream Act Application who are now a US citizen or an eligible noncitizen (permanent resident) and hold a valid Social Security number (SSN), can be processed for 2015-16 Cal Grant renewal under the FAFSA.

- If your school has identified any student in this situation, please contact Institutional Support to convert the Dream ID (Pseudo SSN) to the SSN.
- The student will appear on your roster and all other records under the SSN, as the Dream ID will become inactive.
- Students are flagged on the roster as "Cal Dream Act Application" to indicate the student initially applied and was awarded under the CA Dream Act Application.
- Students who have a SSN through the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) displaying "VALID FOR WORK ONLY WITH DHS AUTHORIZATION" should **not** file a FAFSA.
