

SUBJECT: **2016-17 Child Development Grant Coordinator's Nomination Packet
& Student Application**

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces that the 2016-17 Child Development Grant Program Coordinator's Nomination Packet and Student Application are now available for downloading from our [website](#).

- The Child Development Grant Program is a renewable, need-based grant of up to \$2,000 per year designed to encourage students to enter the field of child care and development in a licensed children's center.
- Students who plan to enroll at least half-time in coursework leading to a Child Development Permit are eligible to apply and be nominated by the postsecondary institution they plan to attend.
- Students must commit to one year of full-time service in a licensed children's center in California for each year they receive the grant.
- Program awards will not be automatically renewed for the 2016-17 academic year. Participants who received an award for 2015-16 must complete a renewal application to be considered for 2016-17 award.
- New and renewal applications must be submitted to the Commission with a postmark no later than **August 31, 2016**.
