SUBJECT: **2016-17 Cal Grant C Awards**

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on the 2016-17 Cal Grant C awards.

The Commission processed the Cal Grant C applicants and offered awards to students who are enrolled in an eligible occupational, technical, or vocational program. Based on the initial Cal Grant C preliminary award cycle:

- Cal Grant C award offers were processed on July 22, 2016.
- Institutions may now view new Cal Grant C recipients on their rosters.
- California Community Colleges awards \$547 for books and supplies.
- Other qualifying colleges and universities award \$547 for books and supplies, plus an additional \$2,462 for tuition and fees.
- The Commission will continue to process Cal Grant C award offers until all 7,761 awards are utilized.

### 2016-17 Cal Grant C Processing Changes

As noted in [GOM 2016-20](#), beginning with the 2016-17 academic year, new legislation required changes to the Cal Grant C Priority List, Occupational List and Scoring Chart:
