This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces updates to the Chafee Foster Youth Grant Program (Chafee Program).

2016-17 Chafee Award and Processing Update

- As of February 6, 2017, 2,997 students have been offered an award.
- Every Monday, beginning February 16, 2017, students with preliminary award dates more than four weeks old who have not been certified as eligible will become ineligible.
 - Award status for these students will change to "Not Awarded Ineligible" and will remain on the payment roster.
 - Awards will be reprocessed for eligible students to ensure that the maximum number of awards are utilized.
 - A separate notification will be sent to students to encourage them to follow up on their Chafee award.
- If an ineligible student becomes eligible at a later time, the institution must update their status using the payment roster.
