This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) reminds district and high school administrators of the following deadlines.

### High School Graduation Verification

- High schools must verify the graduation of students who have not self-certified by **August 31, 2020**. Only students who have been awarded a Cal Grant will need to have their high school graduation verified.
- A student's Cal Grant Entitlement award is placed on hold until the high school graduation requirement is satisfied.
- Verification of high school graduation is done electronically via [WebGrants](#).
  - After logging in, click on WebGrants>GPA>High School Graduate Verification. Please refer to GOM [2020-12](#) for additional details.

### 2021-22 GPA Submission

- GPAs for the class of 2021 must be electronically submitted no later than **October 1, 2020**, as specified under [Education Code 69432.9 \(c\)\(2\)](#), unless the student has opted out, per [Education Code 69432.9 \(d\)\(1\)\(2\)](#). Refer to [GOM 2020-06](#) for additional information on the Opt-Out provision.
  - Schools are strongly encouraged to also submit 2021-22 GPAs for 2020 graduates. High school students have a 2-year window to qualify for a High School Entitlement Cal Grant – as seniors, and the year following graduation.
- GPAs for students who are enrolled in summer school should be uploaded after summer school grades have been posted, as these grades should be included in the GPA calculation.

- Ensure your WebGrants access is current or renew, if needed. Please see the [WebGrants Access Request web page](#) to obtain the necessary WebGrants Access Forms.
