This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces the open registration for the California Cash for College (CCFC) workshop season through the <u>Workshop Management System (WMS)</u>. Statewide CCFC workshops provide free hands-on assistance to students and their family members to complete the FAFSA, CADAA and Chafee Grant for Foster Youth applications. Due to Covid-19, CCFC workshops will transition to a virtual format this year.

To become an approved partner organization and host a CCFC workshop, you must register an account through <u>WMS</u> and schedule a CCFC workshop. This past season, CCFC partners hosted over 1,000 workshops and assisted over 30,000 students.

> Students will be able to search for workshops to attend as soon as they are scheduled in WMS. Therefore, do not wait to register your organization and request a workshop.
