## **Update from the California Student Aid Commission**

SUBJECT: 2022-23 Cal Grant Rosters and Operational Updates

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces the opening of the 2022-23 Cal Grant rosters on **Tuesday, August 23, 2022**, and provides operational updates related to the state budget changes announced in GSA 2022-46.

### **Cal Grant Competitive Awards**

- As announced in <u>GOM 2022-22</u>, the Commission is authorized to make up to 16,000 Competitive Cal Grant Award offers for the 2022-23 academic year. The Commission can provide funding for 13,000 of these awards.
- To preserve a competitive student's award, please report a payment on the roster as soon as possible. This reserves a competitive student's funding for the academic year.
- Starting with the 2021-22 award year, the Commission no longer processes September 2 competitive awards for community college students. These students are processed in the Community College Entitlement (E3) cycle after the September 2 deadline for financial aid applications.

#### **Community College Entitlement Program (E3)**

- Expands Cal Grant A and B entitlement eligibility for students attending a California Community College (CCC), despite not having been awarded at the time of their high school graduation.
- To be considered under the new CCC entitlement program, students must have submitted a 2022-23 FAFSA or California Dream Act Application and have a verified Cal Grant GPA on file with the Commission by September 2.
- Eligible students will be permitted to retain their remaining Cal Grant eligibility when transferring to a UC or CSU campus if they continue to meet all eligibility requirements.
- CCC campuses must submit Enrollment Files and Community College GPAs for students to receive award consideration in the Transfer Entitlement (E2) and the Community College Entitlement (E3) Cycles by September 2, 2022. Please see GOM 2022-28 for more information about submitting Enrollment Files and GPAs.

#### 2022-23 Cal Grant Rosters

- Following the release of the fall advance, full access to the Cal Grant rosters through WebGrants is anticipated on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, for the following students:
  - New high school entitlement students
  - New transfer entitlement students
  - o Renewal students, including renewal competitive students
- The rosters will also reflect the following changes per the 2022-23 state budget:
  - An increase in the maximum Cal Grant A and B tuition award for UC 2022 Cohort students to \$13,104.
  - An increase in the maximum Cal Grant A and B tuition award for new Cal Grant recipients at private non-profit institutions from \$9,220 to \$9,358.
  - Cal Grant Access Awards for students with dependent children and foster youth for students attending private non-profit institutions. Cal Grant A and B students may receive up to \$6,000 and Cal Grant C students may receive up to \$4,000.
- The rosters do not yet reflect the following changes allocated in the 2022-23 budget:
  - o An increase in the maximum Cal Grant A and B tuition award for renewal Cal Grant recipients at private non-profit institutions from \$9,220 to **\$9,358.**

The Commission is currently working to update WebGrants and will provide further operational updates as they become available.
