SUBJECT: 2023-24 Middle Class Scholarship Updates

This Operations Memo from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides updates to the 2023-24 Middle Class Scholarship (MCS) program. The Commission has released a revised version of the 2023-24 MCS Handbook and File Layouts to reflect additional functionality for changes to the student's status.

Student Status Corrections

- Pending system functionality to update the student's status based on enrollment changes during the academic year is now available In WebGrants.
- Campuses can now add or remove academic terms and update the student's status by submitting **term-level** changes to the cost of attendance (COA) field(s). Annual COA corrections will not update the student's status.
- Field #9 of the Enrollment File Layout and field #63 of the Payment-Roster File Layout have been updated to reflect these changes.

2023-24 MCS Handbook Updates

The Commission released an updated version of the 2023-24 MCS Handbook that includes the following changes:

- Added a subchapter describing the student status correction process.
- Added language to year-end reconciliation regarding unused MCS funds and dollar variance tolerance between MCS awards and payments.
- Added language to award eligibility clarifying that students with less than 10% remaining eligibility will not be considered for an MCS award.
- A post-correction awarding formula and examples.
