- Quantifiable success assisting students who receive financial aid as a direct result of the counseling efforts of the nominee.

Arthur Marmaduke served as the Executive Director of the Commission for 25 years. The award was established in 1985 by the Commission to honor the late Arthur Marmaduke for his dedication and commitment toward helping students gain access to postsecondary education through the Commission's grant, scholarship and loan assumption programs. The selected nominee will receive a certificate in recognition of his/her contributions.
