- The CCFC workshop series is a partnership effort of high schools, community colleges, universities, and community groups funded by the Commission, campuses, regional CCFC Coordinating Organizations (RCOs) and local organizations.
- To help ensure that each workshop achieves the mission of assisting low income and first generation college-bound high school seniors apply for all possible financial aid, CCFC offers outreach materials, student follow-up tools, and available social marketing or other marketing resources.

- > Access to student contact information for requested financial aid follow-up
- > Ability to request site support funds
