This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) reminds Cal Grant and Middle Class Scholarship (MCS) participating institutions that the **final reconciliation date** for the 2015-16 academic year is **Friday**, **September 9**, **2016**, as originally announced in <u>GSA 2016-16</u> released May 19, 2016.
