## Update from the California Student Aid Commission

SUBJECT: **Governor's Executive Order and other Cal Grant Updates**

This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces Governor Newsom's [Executive Order](#) (EO) that includes two provisions to ease certain administrative requirements for Cal Grant eligibility. The EO addresses the following Cal Grant requirements (see items 6) and 7) in EO). Additionally, the Commission is addressing its current practices to verify high school graduation for graduating seniors to ease their administrative burden.

### **Late Grade Point Average (GPA)**

Recognizing the difficulties potential Cal Grant entitlement students may have in securing a verified 2020-21 GPA while schools and offices are closed due to COVID-19 restrictions, the May 18, 2020 deadline is extended through **September 2, 2020**. This applies to Cal Grant Entitlement students who filed a California Dream Act Application (CADAA) or Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the March 2, 2020 deadline.

### **Selective Service Verification for Dream Act Applicants**

The requirement to verify Selective Service registration is waived for applicants who apply for Cal Grant aid using the California Dream Act Application (CADAA) for grants received for the 2019-20 and 2020-21 academic years.

### **Verification of High School Graduation**

In addition to the Executive Order, the Commission is encouraging new Cal Grant applicants graduating from high school in 2020 to self-certify their high school graduation in the event that their school is unable to do so due to school closures. Students can log onto their [WebGrants 4 Students](#) account to determine the next steps in accessing their Cal Grant award.
