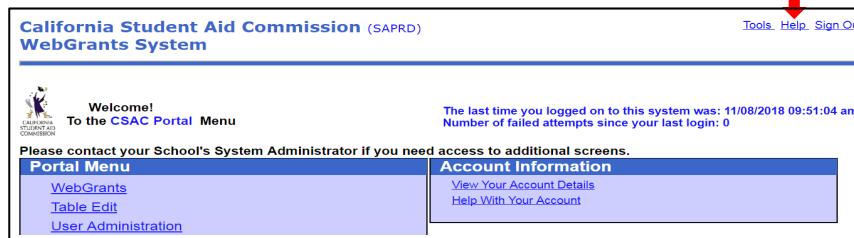

SUBJECT: **2020-21 Unpaid Competitive Cal Grant Award Status**

This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) provides an update on 2020-21 competitive Cal Grant A and B awards.

- To date, 35,269 of the 41,000 competitive awards have been paid for the 2020-21 academic year, an 86% paid rate.
- In order to reach a 100% paid rate, new competitive awards will be offered to the next cohort of eligible applicants. If you have eligible unpaid competitive students on your roster, please make it a priority to post a payment or corresponding transaction code as soon as possible and no later than **5:00 p.m. on April 23, 2021.**
 - Note that records marked 'FI' (File Incomplete) will be withdrawn.
- Unpaid competitive awardees will be notified via email that their awards will be withdrawn if eligible transaction codes are not posted by April 23, 2021.
- Institutions are advised to customize their WebGrants roster to identify unpaid awarded students.

The Commission will continue to monitor the paid rate to ensure that payments do not exceed the 41,000 competitive awards available for this academic year.
