SUBJECT: 2022-23 Online California Dream Act Application

This Special Alert from the California Student Aid Commission (Commission) announces the release of the 2022-23 California Dream Act Application (CADAA) on **October 1, 2021**, to align with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). As announced in <u>GSA 2021-40</u>, the Commission launched the new online CADAA on August 31, 2021. The CADAA can be found on the Dream Act web portal located at <u>dream.csac.ca.gov</u>.

As a reminder, undocumented students who meet the requirements per California Education Code Section 68130.5, as amended, commonly known as AB 540, are eligible to apply through the CADAA to receive state financial aid consideration. Meeting the requirements of Section 68130.5 also allows students to qualify for in-state tuition.
