From our Executive Director, Marlene Garcia:

Happy new year, 2024! As everyone knows, both the FAFSA and California Dream Act Application (CADAA) recently launched, and many students and their families have successfully started the process to qualify for financial aid. Although there have been some issues encountered with the FAFSA, we have been notified that the U.S. Department of Education is making every effort to resolve them. As we all know, the release of many updated technologies frequently results in various challenges; however, the goal is to improve the user experience, and streamline the process. We believe that the changes to Better FAFSA will make it easier for students and families to apply for financial aid. So, encourage students to persist and complete their 2024-25 applications.

What's the Latest?

FAFSA and CADAA are open!

Both financial aid applications are open, and students can begin applying for financial aid for the 2024-25 academic year. Students only need to complete one application. The state priority deadline in California is April 2, 2024. Some colleges may have earlier deadlines for institutional aid, and students should check with their colleges to make sure they are meeting those deadlines. Keep in mind for the Better FAFSA, the planned maintenances announced by Federal Student Aid (FSA) have impacted the experience for some applicants. We encourage students to be patient and persistent in completing their applications.
