The new WebGrants 4 Students (WG4S) application supports the two latest versions of the following browsers:

- IE Version : 11.973.17763.0
- Chrome Version 80.0.3987.87
- Firefox Version 72.0.2 (64-bit)
- IE Edge Version 78.0.276.8
- Safari version 12



Supporting that version. All browsers must have cookies and JavaScript enabled to use the WG4S application.

It is recommended that your mobile device, Android OS or Apple iOS is also updated with the latest version when using the WG4S application.

Organizations and Students who depend on older versions of Internet Explorer need to upgrade to the latest version or use a different browser from the supported list above. Users with unsupported browsers may find that some features do not function, or the application does not load.

Internet Options

- 1. Open Internet Explorer.
- 2. Select the "Tools" menu.
- 3. Select "Internet Options"
- 4. Select the "Security" tab.
- 5. Click the "Custom Level" button. Custom level.
- Scroll down and change the Active Scripting setting to Enable.
 Scripting Active scripting
- 7. Click okay to confirm the change.
- 8. JavaScript is now enabled.
- *Takes effect after you restart your computer

Internet Explorer (IE)

How to Find Your Internet Browser Version Number

- Open Internet Explorer. This app resembles a light-blue "e" with a gold band encircling it.
- 2. Click Settings in upper right-hand corner.
- 3. Click About Internet Explorer. It's at the bottom of the drop-down menu.
- 4. Review your Internet Explorer version.





Google Chrome How to Enable JavaScript

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click the three dots located at the top of the screen.
- 3. At the bottom, click expand Advanced.
- 4. Under "Privacy and security," click Site Settings.
- 5. Click JavaScript.
- 6. Turn on Allowed (recommended).

Mozilla Firefox How to Enable JavaScript

- 1. Open the Firefox menu.
- 2. Click the Tools drop-down menu and select Options.
- 3. Select the Content section from the options at the top of the pop-up page.
- 4. Check the boxes next to Block pop-up windows, Load images automatically, and Enable JavaScript.
- 5. Click OK.
- 6. Refresh your browser by right-clicking anywhere on the page and selecting Reload, or by using the Reload button in the toolbar.

Mozilla Firefox

How to Find Your Internet Browser Version Number

- 1. Open the Firefox menu. Open Firefox, then press the menu button.
- 2. Touch the Help icon. This is a question mark inside a circle.
- 3. Select About Firefox. Select this from the list that appears when you select Help.
- 4. Check the version number.

The version number is located just below the word Firefox.

JavaScript is included with MS Windows Updates and is not generally controlled using the settings/preferences/options as other browsers.

How to Enable JavaScript

- 1. Open the Safari application by clicking on the icon in the Dock.
- 2. Go to the Safari menu at the top and select Preferences.
- 3. Click on the Security tab at the top of the Preferences window.
- 4. Check the box next to Enable JavaScript.
- 5. Close the Preferences window to save the settings.

Internet Explorer/Edge/Windows 10 Update

- 1. On windows computer Click start.
- 2. Click gear icon.

- 4. Click Check for updates.

Chrome

- 1. Open Chrome on your computer.
- 2. On the top right click the three dots icon.
- 3. Hover over Help.

- 5. Updater will run from there.
- 6. After Updater finishes close and relaunch browser to complete update.

Firefox

- 1. Open Firefox on your computer.
- 2. Click the hamburger button.
- 3. Click Help.
- 4. Click About Firefox.
- 5. Updater will run from there.
- 6. After Updater finishes close and relaunch browser to complete update.

Safari on MacOS

- 1. Open the app store by click the apple icon on the top left.
- 2. Click App Store.
- 3. Click Updates tab.
- 4. Find Safari and click update.
- 5. After Updater finishes close and relaunch browser to complete update.
